# Angel Ring Update

12<sup>th</sup> March 2005

## More Angel Rings Installed

On the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2005 the 65th Angel Ring was installed at Crampton Island, within the Meroo National Park, south of Ulladulla. This ring was significant in the fact that a request was made by the family of a teenager and keen angler who drowned at this spot.

For the past 12 months the entire community has assisted ANSA NSW throughout the planning, management and finally the installation of the ring. The local National Parks ranger, Meghan Kempster assisted throughout the planning phase and site selection and also assisted with the installation, John Wells from Shoalhaven City Council who supported the project from its early stages and the manager of Lake Tabourie Tourist Park, Cornell Van-Ryn who helped with the installation and has offered to assist with the management of the ring and raising rock safety awareness within the area. Paul Howe from Lake Burril Bait and Tackle will also help with the management and will coordinate the replacement of any lost rings through his shop.
