# NSW Angel Ring Update

7<sup>th</sup> September 2009

## 100 Installed Angel Rings

Within the next four weeks, the Angel Ring Project that ANSA NSW has managed since 1994 will hit the 100 ring milestone. With 91 installed rings to date, 9 more locations have been approved within NSW.

One ring is destined for the iconic Outer Tubes of Jervis Bay and this will be installed by the Australian Land Based Anglers (ALBAA) on the 19<sup>th</sup> September 2009. This will coincide with their clean up at the Outer Tubes in conjunction with the Department of Defence. Eight more rings will then be installed on the northern beaches of Sydney. Locations range from Whale Beach to Mona Vale and are scheduled for installation over the October long weekend. Six more rings are planned for the Kurnell side of Botany Bay National Park, with approval due in early October.

## Port Kembla Rockfishing Safety Day

On the 14<sup>th</sup> of September the Angel Ring Team will be down at Hill 60 and will be talking to local and visiting anglers about the being prepared when rockfishing. Initially the team will be installing 3 multilingual signs on the rocks, before moving onto the rock platforms to give out free translated DVDs and free lifejackets to anglers. In conjunction with the NSW Coroner and the local council, ANSA NSW is working on upgrading the 3 angel rings installations in the area to carry an additional glow in the dark life buoy and solar lighting over the posts.
